

**MINUTES OF THE
FOREST ACRES SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
January 27, 2015**

Mayor Frank Brunson and council members Ginger Dukes, Curt Rye, Jr., Beau Powell and Shell Suber were present, along with City Administrator Mark Williams, Assistant City Administrator Jake Broom, Police Chief Gene Sealy and City Attorney Lee Holloway.

Mayor Brunson called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

1. **Second Reading: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF FOREST ACRES, STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF FOREST ACRES, BE AMENDED BY REVISING THE TEMPORARY SECTION OF SAID CODE; PROVIDING THE DATES FOR: PUBLIC NOTICE OF 2015 GENERAL ELECTION, DEADLINE FOR FILING STATEMENTS OF CANDIDACY AND 2015 GENERAL ELECTION.**

On a motion by Mrs. Dukes, seconded by Mr. Rye, council unanimously approved the ordinance.

2. **Forest Drive Corridor Study Update; The Boudreaux Group, Toole Design Group, Landplan Group South.**

Council received an update on the progress made on the Forest Drive Corridor Study from Irene Dumas-Tyson (Boudreaux Group), Ernie Boughman (Toole Design Group), Rick McMackin (Landplan Group South) and Hoyt Burnett (Landplan Group South).

No action was taken regarding the update.

3. **First Reading: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF FOREST ACRES, STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF FOREST ACRES, BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 10-13 OF SAID CODE PROVIDING FOR PARKS, IN ORDER TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) PROHIBITED ACTS BY ADDING ADDITIONAL PROHIBITIONS.**

Administrator Williams informed council that citizens recently brought large inflatable play equipment to one of the parks for a birthday party. Staff would like to modify the ordinance to more clearly prohibit such play equipment as well as additional items.

Council agreed unanimously to defer the ordinance to the February 10th, 2015 council meeting to allow themselves time to read the ordinance and consider what should be prohibited before acting.

There being no further business, on a motion by Mr. Rye, seconded by Mrs. Dukes, council voted unanimously to adjourn at 5:25 p.m.
